

# PRESENTATION


The University of Lleida is a Catalan public university with a universal vocation which works in the service of society with three main goals. The first is higher education, which provides graduates with human and professional values and adds value to the society in which they work. The second, which is fundamental, is the production of knowledge through research and its transfer to society, which converts it into well-being and progress. Finally, there is social commitment, which means working for justice and equal opportunities for everyone, the sustainability of the production systems and livelihood of the population and cooperation as an instrument to meet these goals here and everywhere. The aim of this document is to present the main goals and milestones achieved in these three fundamental pillars of university activity.

# STUDIES OFFERED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF LLEIDA

Teaching is the fundamental activity that allows the university to be able to fulfil its mission: to train professionals and citizens not just to be good professionals but also to enable them to acquire ethical values and to have a commitment to society. The UdL offers a flexible teaching and education model characterized by promoting dual training, the adoption of innovative teaching methodologies, personalization and proximity to students, with a strong interconnection between teaching and research and a lifelong learning catalogue geared toward demand and vocational retraining.

Bachelor's degrees, master's degrees, doctoral degrees and continuing education are part of the higher education offered at the university to improve professional competencies and contribute to the economic and social development of its environment.

Over the last five years, the University of Lleida has increased the number of students enrolled, reaching a figure of over 10,000 students taking official qualifications and more than 2,000 in continuing education.


## Resources mobilized for RDI activities





# COMMITMENT TO SOCIETY, CULTURE, EQUALITY AND COOPERATION

The university's two missions — the generation and transmission of knowledge — make sense insofar as these activities contribute to the development of the societies they serve and the people who make them up. The value of universities is directly proportional to their contribution to the progress of society and the well-being of people. Its mission also involves guaranteeing equality, improving employability, promoting health, catering for diversity, being committed to environmental sustainability, contributing to the economic development of the region and promoting culture and internationalization, giving meaning to the two principles.

The UdL makes a remarkable effort in this sphere. It allocates almost €440,000 of its budget to promoting equal opportunities for its students, especially those in an economic, family or personal situation which affects their training process. Notable results are likewise obtained from the rest of the actions undertaken.

As regards results, it is worth noting that for every €100 of funding received from the Generalitat of Catalonia, the UdL generates €301 of integrated social value and that it has more than 5,000 m<sup>2</sup> of active roofs in operation, generating 100% clean energy.







Especially noteworthy is the impact on SDG 12 Responsible consumption and production (55), SDG 13 Climate Action (52) and SDG 3 Health and Wellness (45).


## 2030 Agenda at the UdL

- ✓ Participation in the UdL Shelter Programme, to accommodate people from countries in conflict to resume studies in Catalonia.


